

Application for the Issuance of a Certificate according to Technical Guidelines by the German Federal Office for Information Security (BSI)

Hereby the applicant specified under No. 1 applies for issuance of a Certificate according to Technical Guidelines for the IT-product/-system specified under No. 4.¹

² The notification of a sponsor is only required, if the applicant will not pay the costs of the certification procedure.

³ A Re-Certification is the process to maintain a conformity statement after a certified product/system has been modified and it can not be excluded, that the changes conducted have no influence regarding its certified functionality respectively its conformity to the relevant Technical Guideline. A Re-Certification requires a complete or partial re-evaluation of the product's/system's conformity.

⁴ A Maintenance-Procedure is performed to extend the validity of an existing certificate according to Technical Guidelines onto additional product/system versions, if it is ensured, that the modifications/Changes have no influence regarding the certified functionality respectively the conformity of the product/system.

⁵ Together with an application for a Maintenance-Procedure a detailed description of all modification/changes with an impact analysis as well as an updated configuration list (→ see Conformity Report Chapter 'Components of the TOE') MUST be provided as attachments.

⁶ The notification of an evaluation facility or auditor is usually not required, if the application concerns the performance of a Maintenance-Procedure.

8. Time Schedule for the Conformity Evaluation⁸

9. Certification Documents

The certification documents (Certificate according to Technical Guidelines, Conformity Report and – if requested – Certification Button & Test Seal) issued upon positive conclusion of the certification procedure shall be provided in the following language:⁹

11. Archiving of the Certified Product and the Evaluation Documents

The applicant commits to archive the product/system specified under No. 4 in its certified configuration(s) together with all documentation and evidence provided for the performance of the conformity evaluation for a time frame of 5 years. Within this time frame the certified product/system and all archived documentation/evidence will be made available to BSI upon request (e. g. for the purpose of re-examination of the certificate) at any time and exempt from charges.

The applicant agrees that BSI archives all internal files as well as all documentation provided. The applicant further agrees that the evaluation facility/auditor archives the results and test reports of the conformity evaluation performed.

12. Announcement upon positive Conclusion of the Certification Procedure

In case a certificate is issued the applicant agrees to the publication of the certification result and the Conformity Report – completely or in parts, also in electronic form – by BSI.

Upon positive conclusion of the certification procedure the product/system will be added to the list or products/systems certified according to Technical Guidelines. This list is published on the BSI website.

14. Costs

For the performance of the certification procedure BSI will charge for fees and expenses (e. g. travel expenses) according to the BSI Regulation on Ex-Parte Costs (BSI-KostV) which is valid at the time of application. Fees and expenses will also be charged, if the application is withdrawn or an objection against an administrative decision is filed (§ 2 BSI-KostV).

If not stated otherwise by BSI payment is due ten days after announcing the determination of charges to the applicant/debtor (§14 BGebG). Differing conditions of payment by the applicant are not accepted.

The applicant agrees that BSI will charge for fees and expenses.

⁷ A list of the evaluation facilities currently recognized by BSI according to DIN ISO/IEC 17025 as well as a list of the auditors (→ 'Auditteamleiter') certified by BSI are published on the BSI website: www.bsi.bund.de/zertifizierungtr

⁸ The notification of a time schedule is usually not required, if the application concerns the performance of a Maintenance-Procedure.

⁹ The certification documents (Certificate according to Technical Guidelines, Conformity Report, Certification Button, Test Seal) will be issued either in German or in English language. Due to administrative regulations only a German version of the associated Notification of Conformity can be issued and signed. For additional or subsequent translations of certification documents by BSI additional costs will incur.

¹⁰ A Test Seal will only be issued for hardware products. The usage of the Test Seal is optional. Only if a Certification according to Technical Guidelines is a prerequisite for the official/governmental deployment of a product, the application of the Test Seal (if procurable) is mandatory to indicate its certified status.

¹¹ An order number must only be notified, if required for the applicant's/sponsor's accounting.
